- Most of my sales pages are created in WordPress (some are on Leadpages which I'll show in the sales page module)
- · ALL of my course pages are created in WordPress
 - My membership site is a plug in
- · You can password protect pages if you don't want to spend the \$\$\$
- · Lots of free themes, super customizable
- · Show tour inside wordpress

Creating pages for your course

- · I will put one module per page on my website
- · Add a header of the course
- · Add pretty pictures, wording etc
- Embed my Vimeo hosted video
- Add homework or bonuses onto the page
- · Password protect the page
- \cdot and BOOM
- I leave the sales page for the VERY end after my entire course is put together so I know EXACTLY what's inside my course!



- Before I just password protected my course videos & trusted the links didn't get shared. If you're a beginner this is great.
- I didn't choose to do wishlist member until I got serious about course creation
- It was SO worth the \$200
- Wishlist is a plug in that creates a membership log in on your website for certain pages
- Each of you had to go through WishList to get into DCB
- Each student who enrolls into course gets a unique password and username.
 Minimizes course sharing by giving someone the general password.
